- Write a non-chronological report about the Ancient Egyptians – you could include - rivers, pyramids, the gods, housing, food and the pharaohs.
- Read the legend of Osiris and Isis then rewrite the story in your own words. Your story should be descriptive and engaging for your reader.



Topic

- Cleopatra has inspired many movies and plays and is one of the most famous female rulers in history, but who was she? Write a fact file all about Cleopatra VII.
- Draw a map of Egypt and then label all the famous cities and landmarks in the country. You could draw it on paper, on a computer or even make a 3D model! Be as creative as you like!

Maths

Create a project to see how much it would cost for you and your family to go on holiday to Egypt. You need to include, flights, accommodation and spending money. If there are four people in your family, you will need to multiply each of these by four.

The Egyptians created Hieratic Numerals. Using these numerals, create addition, subtraction, multiplication and division questions that you can then solve.
