Use a large tub of water to clean or 'bath' any animals you may have. You could wash muddy cars, clean the dinosaurs or give any dolls or teddies a wash!



Rainbow Nature Hunt - When you go on a walk see if you can find exciting things – can you collect items that are all different colours?



Using a paint brush and some water – see what you can create outside! You can make marks, try writing words or just draw a picture.



See how many different ways you can write your own name. If you already can then try practising your key words.



Choose your favourite teddy bear and read them a story. See how many different books you can read!



See if you can draw your own hopscotch! This is great for recognising numerals and good exercise too.



Create your own shadow drawings, this can be any animal or small world object. Have fun!
