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Phonics lessons begin on Monday 27th April following 'Letters and Sounds', which is the scheme we use in school.

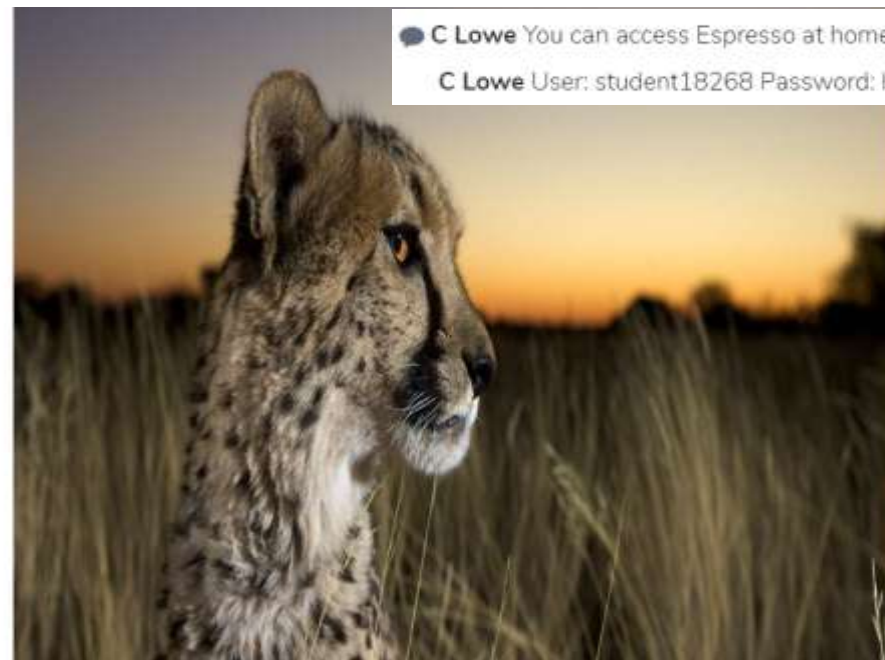
