We will collect items and then send them to Caritas to be distributed. Please send in any items by 13th October with your child. Many thanks.




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Home/Remote Learning

Their work can be done directly onto Seesaw or it can be written/drawn and a photograph added. They can also post pictures of scores on spelling shed, timetables Rockstars or any online learning also.



The app you can use as a parent and family to see multiple children's work is Seesaw family.



In preparation for any future closure we ask that children in Year 1-6 download the app 'Teams'. Children in Years 1-6 have been allocated email addresses. The children will use their school email to be able to log in to live teaching sessions, should a further lockdown or bubble closure happen. Work will still be set on seesaw and the teachers and staff will comment via the app. **The staff are in constant communication with your children through the seesaw app.**
