One way system

Please note the one way system and now the building work has been completed the new exit.

The entrance and one way around school will still be the same, however you will be able to exit via the steps next to the new KS1 area. **If you have a push chair or require a disabled exit this will be the entrance gate.**

Unfortunately, we are finding some families are continuing to send pupils to school in the above circumstances and this is seriously jeopardising both the integrity of our school bubbles and the safety of the whole school community. If we have evidence that families are in breach of these rules we will be forwarding details to the Public Health team and they will take whatever action they feel appropriate. Fines for those breaking the rules now start at £1,000 and increase up to £10,000 for repeat offenders
